











They are some of the granitic islands that form the Archipelago of Lavezzi, classified Reinforced Protection Zone of the Nature Reserve.

The Iles de Lavezzi are a group of small, barren uninhabited granite islands, 10 km southeast off the coast of Bonifacio, with beautiful shell sand beaches and azure-colored sea. 
A private dive with a qualified instructor to discover the astonishing diversity of the underwater life and scenery. Windsurfing kayak or paddle surf are nice options to do here.




